Elements Learning Collaborative(ELC) offers year round learning opportunities for children and families. Our mission is to provide children of diverse backgrounds with holistic, joyful and child-centered learning experiences in nature; ones that foster social and emotional development as well as responsibility and independence. Summer Elements Nature Camp has been in operation since 2018, and hosts 15 children for 3-day long sessions. An average of 50 individual campers of elementary school age attend each summer. Using the natural setting of the farm, fields, and nature trials we provide a holistic learning approach where the curriculum is based on local ecosystems, healthy movement, food systems, art, literature, cultural studies, mathematics, science, anti bias curriculum, music & social thinking. Elements programs operate at Round the Bend Farm: A Center for Restorative Community in South Dartmouth, MA.

Job Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with Directors to plan summer curriculum and themes.

- Carry out planned lessons with small groups of 4-15 learners of mixed ages and abilities.
- Facilitate transitions throughout the day, supporting children to follow guidelines.
- Closely supervise the children outdoors, maintaining child to staff ratios.
- Establish and maintain harmonious group dynamics.
- Provide Camp Counselors with planning support & feedback.
- Be familiar with the Staff Handbook, Family Welcome Guide, program policies and procedures, as well as teaching philosophy and methods applied at Elements.
